



Beginning Wednesday, January 5th 2022, Whitetail Disposal will be providing new automated service for the **Borough of Freemansburg** utilizing new 96-gallon trash totes!

*****Effective January 2022*****

Each residence will be allocated one 96-gallon tote for trash. You can expect delivery of the totes to be between *December 21st and December 24th*.

Wednesday will be the new day of the week for collection. If a holiday occurs on a Wednesday, collection will be delayed until Thursday.

Borough of Freemansburg will still handle any billing questions or concerns.

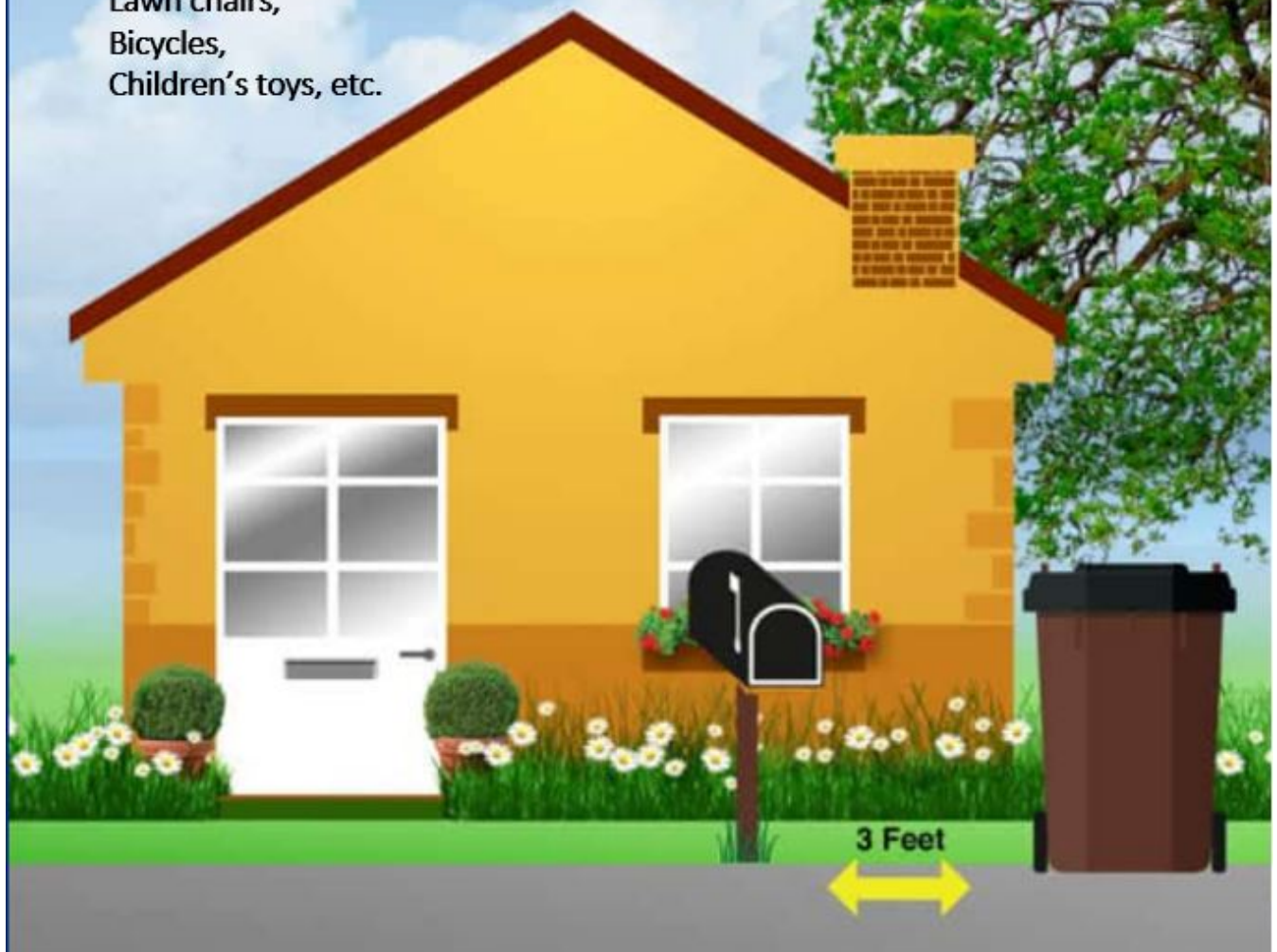

*Make sure that the WHEELS ON YOUR TRASH CART ARE TOWARDS THE HOUSE so that all waste materials are emptied

*Be sure to place all waste in the specified container

*Wheel the cart to the end of your driveway prior to your service day

*Do not place anything you do not wish to be picked Up near your cart. For example,
Lawn chairs,
Bicycles,
Children's toys, etc.



Bulk Item Collection

All bulk items such as furniture or household items should be scheduled in advance by contacting the office of Freemansburg Borough to purchase a bulk sticker.

Examples include: sofa, chair, table, desk, mattresses (must be wrapped in plastic), toilet (must be bagged), vanity etc....

All hazardous and e-waste items *require special disposal* and are classified as *non-standard items*.
